Conversation with City Commissioner At Large Hon. Hagen Brody

- a. Project update:
 - i. 10th & 14th street round-abouts, 2-year projects expected completion by December 2020
 - ii. Citrus Square is close to completion
 - iii. Lofts on Lemon should be breaking ground early next year, which will include small park open to the public.
 - iv. Gulfstream roundabout in the coming years
 - v. Lofts on Lemon -- a percentage of the units are set aside for teachers. Brody hopes that additional units will house other government workers.
 - vi. Housing Authority agreed to allow the public to use the Lofts on Lemon park, but keeping the park under control of the Housing Authority enables them to remove people who become a nuisance.
 - vii. Brody believes that impact fees should be used in the neighborhood in which they were generated.
